

The UUCGL Social Action Committee (SAC) stimulates, supports, and encourages work for social justice among congregants. Social action takes place in many places within the church, including committees, both youth and adult religious education classes, covenant groups, and individuals working with outside entities. The SAC is an umbrella committee with justice ministry teams that carry out activities with defined, and often intersecting, foci. Current foci include Ending New Jim Crow, Gun Violence Prevention, Environmental Justice, Special Plate Collections, Immigration Justice, and Reproductive Justice. SAC teams work with other faith and non-profit groups to leverage their involvement. On the third Sunday evening of each month, a social justice event which is open to the public is held. It usually includes a film or panel presentation and discussion with audience participation. The event is free of charge. All are welcome!
