After an early morning flight from Detroit Metro to New York's LaGuardia airport, the group toured [UN Headquarters](#). They witnessed the Security Council chambers, the General Assembly building, the retired Trusteeship Council room, and observed many works of art provided to the UN by various member nations. The students were also privileged to watch the [Conference of Indigenous Peoples](#), representing groups worldwide.

The remaining brief time was spent seeing a Broadway play, and taking a historical sightseeing boat trip around southern Manhattan, with close-up sighting of the majestic and inspiring [Statue of Liberty](#), views of the new [One World Trade Center](#), the [Empire State Building](#), the [Brooklyn Bridge](#), [Battery Park](#), and more. The tour was thoroughly enjoyed by all.
